## Small Group/Sermon Notes for Foundational Truths Part 2: Faith In God

Remember, small groups are primarily for growing closer relationships with other believers. We can learn wonderful things in this environment but keep relationships first.

- Make sure everyone knows each other's names. Have everyone share a little about themselves and how life is going right now.
- Foundational Truths: Set Up
- This is a series about maturing in the faith.
- Our text: **Hebrews 5:11-6:3** 
  - o God expects us to be growing and maturing over time.
  - o AND we are to have faith like a little child!
- This Week: Faith In God
- Faith is the catalyst that unlocks the power of God: **Matthew 17:18-20** 
  - o In your life, in the church, in the Kingdom of God!
- God's power is there whether you apprehend it or not.
  - o Ex: forgiveness.
  - o It is faith which allows you to tap into God's power. Hebrews 4:2
    - The Gospel is of NO VALUE without faith!
    - Whose word is most powerful in your life: yours, someone else's, or God's?
      - It is the one you believe. Put your faith in God!!
- Faith IN God vs faith in other things. I've seen Christians do each of these three.
  - o Faith in faith.
    - This is when you feel guilty for not having enough faith so you grit your teeth and try to have more faith.
    - That isn't faith in God. It is faith in your faith.
    - Faith come by hearing. **Romans 10:17**
  - o Faith in pretending.
    - This is when you say you have faith in God, but you ignore God and do it your own way. (Don't forgive, don't bear fruit, etc)
    - Basketball Coach with last play example.
      - This is just a mess. **Titus 1:16**
  - o Faith in catastrophes.
    - This one is directly self destructive, but people don't always see it.
    - What "saves" you from the History test when you are a kid?
      - People get addicted to chaos and catastrophes. Not good.
      - They prefer and excuse for failure over success.
    - Instead of that, have faith to overcome! John 16:33
- Real Faith in God:
  - o Real faith loves God. I mean that. Understand what that means.
    - To love God, get to know God! (More than knowing about God.)
  - o Is fully convinced that God's ways are the best ways.
    - That God is good. That His commands are there to help you. That if we can just find God's ways we will find abundant life!
  - o Knows what God has promised and what He hasn't.
    - Do you want to know what God has promised? Read your Bible!!!
    - Then believe (act on!) God's promises!
  - o Is not shaken by circumstances.
    - Hey, reevaluate often. But I love Daniel 3:14-18
  - o Knows that, when we stick with God, we are going to win in the end!
    - Be encouraged! It is a long road but good things are on the other side!
  - Pray for each other before you finish up!
