Small Group/Sermon Notes based on Tasked 1

Remember, small groups are primarily for growing closer relationships with other believers. We can learn wonderful things in this environment but keep relationships first.

- Make sure everyone knows each other's names. Have everyone share a little about themselves and how life is going right now.
- Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to follow Christ!
 - O Did you know you are on a mission from God?
- Two ways of thinking:
 - No cosmic plan. Stuff happens, doesn't mean anything.
 - Each person can look around and figure out for themselves what they want to do.
 - This is not a Christian way of thinking.
 - Yes cosmic plan! God has a plan. History has a purpose. You are part of it!
 - Each person can discover their calling inside of God's overall plan.
 - This is a very important part of Christian thinking.
- Key verse: **John 15:16.**
 - o "You did not choose me."
 - We can respond in various ways to being called...(talk on that later)
 - "And appointed you." So, Jesus chose and tasked the disciples.
 - Is that true for you and me too?
- An important parable: Matthew 22:1-14.
 - The King is repeatedly dismissed. Then the servants are mistreated.
 - Matthew 22:9 is very important. This leaves room for you and me!
 - Matthew 22:10 drives that point home!!!
 - What is the deal about the wedding clothes?
 - Good and bad are invited. The bad are not chosen however.
 - You must clothe yourself with Christ. Everything you need is available to you for that.
 Galatians 3:26-29.
 - Matthew 22:14 is interesting.
 - Many are invited or called few are chosen or elect.
 - How do you go from invited to chosen?
- Let's look at three types of responses to the call of God:
 - Moses: I think you've got the wrong guy!
 - **Exodus 3:1-11, 4:1, 4:10-14.**
 - God was very patient but He finally got sick of it!
 - Jonah: Forget it.
 - Jonah 1:1-3.
 - Don't be like that. It did not work out well for Jonah.
 - Noah: I'm in.
 - **Genesis 6:22.**
 - That's what we are going for.
- God has a plan. You are called to be part of it.
 - o Don't run from God. That turns out bad.
 - Trust that God can make you who you need to be.
 - God equips the chosen. It isn't done on your strength anyway!
 - Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to follow Christ.
 - You in?
