## Small Group/Sermon Notes for High Ways Part 3: Sharing Your Faith

Remember, small groups are primarily for growing closer relationships with other believers. We can learn wonderful things in this environment but keep relationships first.

- Make sure everyone knows each other's names. Have everyone share a little about themselves and how life is going right now.
- Key Scripture **Isaiah 55:6-9** 
  - o God's ways are higher than our ways x2:
    - First, God's ways can be hard to understand sometimes.
    - Second, God's ways are much much better than our ways.
- This week: Sharing Your Faith.
- Let's talk about the obligation to 'share your faith.'
  - o Obviously important, but also frequently awkward and ineffective! Thoughts?
- Jesus and Nicodemus. **John 3:1-17.** 
  - o What are your takeaways from these verses? But we need to read the next few verses.
  - o John 3:18-21.
    - Not too many John 3:18 signs at football games!!
- We must understand that there are two possible destinies for each individual person.
  - o Eternal life and condemnation. This isn't popular in today's world, but everyone doesn't win.
    - Scary verse **Matthew 7:13-14.** Maybe most lose??
      - This haunts me. I wept at **Romans 9:1-3.**
  - o Eternal life is available to everyone. The price has been paid. All that is left is receiving it.
- The Paradigm Shift. (Credits to Andy Stanley.)
  - o Who do you have no respect for? No time for? Who you are disgusted by?
  - o In Jesus day there were various groups viewed like that. Sinners. Lepers.
  - o Jesus changed that. Luke 5:12-13.
    - What does that fact that Jesus reached out and touched the man show about God?
  - o Jesus at Matthew's house. Matthew 9:9-13.
    - Jesus came to save sinners! To sacrifice for the hated outcasts!!!
  - o Instead of rejecting the sinner and the leper Jesus calls us to be friend and help them!
    - (Who do you have no respect for? No time for? Who you are disgusted by?)
    - But, who are you and I but cleansed sinners and lepers ourselves!
- Problem: Too many people think, "I hate my life" "I hate myself" "I hate them."
  - o Jesus says, "Don't hate yourself. I love you."
    - Response is to love Jesus back and see yourself rightly.
  - o That's a good start but don't stop there!!!
    - I think releasing hate is very difficult when you have a false self-concept. (thoughts?)
    - Once you are forgiven and loved you can become secure enough in who you are in Christ to forgive and love others.
  - o Jesus says, "Don't hate them. I love them."
    - When you catch this then sharing your faith ceases to be an obligation.
    - They need to be freed and cleansed just like you!
- Some quick observations:
  - o Different people have different roles. Just be your best you! Not everyone is an evangelist.
  - o The Holy Spirit draws people. Don't force things but help people.
  - o Best thing is to simply share what God has done for you.
- What has God done for you?
  - o If you're not sure what to say to that, today is the day to change that!
  - o Let's live in the power of God so we have something to share!!
- Pray for each other before you finish up!
